SCHEDULED UTILITY WORKS ON BANCHORY AVENUE, HILLSIDE

Dear Families.

This notice is to advise of scheduled utility works will commence on Banchory Avenue prior to the end of Term 3 by Total Underground Boring & Drilling Solutions (TUS).

A road crossing for power conduits to connect to a new power electrical sub-station is required. Both motor vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be impacted on Banchory Avenue in the vicinity of the sub-station location. Indented car parking bays will also be temporarily unavailable for use

Traffic flow management (stop/go) will be provided by TUS for the duration of the scheduled works. Cana Leadership recommend families plan their travel to and from Cana to allow for possible time delay, or alternatively, try to avoid using Banchory Avenue during the scheduled work dates.

Permitted work hours: from 9.15am to 2.30pm Monday to Friday during the above dates.


Canteen Service

This is particularly important in the event that the person making a school fee payment has a different surname to the surname listed on the school fee account.

When doing your child's enrolment there will be some information and documents that you will need on hand to complete the process.

- Credit card or bank account details for direct debit purposes
- Emergency contact details in case you are not contactable in an emergency
- Authorised nominees for drop off and collection
- Doctor, Medicare, immunisations details for your child
- Any medical or health details for your child

The Child Safe Standards

The safety of each child at Cane is of the ulmost importance. It is our duty of care to ensure each child feels safe within all environments including school, home, and the community.

To comply with the <u>Ministerial Order No. 1359 – Implementing the Child Safe Standards</u>, Cana is required to meet the Child Safe Standards 1-11. Below is an outline of each Child Safe standard. More information on each standard can be found here: The 11 Child Safe Standards

Standard 1; To establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued.

Standard 2: Child safety and wellbeing are embedded in organisational leadership, governance, and culture.

Standard 3: Children and young people are empowered about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously.

Standard 4: Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing.

Standard 5: Equity is upheld, and diverse needs respected in policy and practice.

<u>Standard 5</u>: People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.

Standard 7: Processes for complaints and concerns are child focused.


Standard 8: Staff and volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills, and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training.

Standard 9: Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed.

Standard 10; Implementation of the Child Safe Standards is regularly reviewed and improved.

Standard 11: Policies and procedures document how the school is safe for children and young people.

In future editions of the newsletter, each Child Safe Standard will be explored in further detail with examples of how it is implemented at Cana.
