## **2025 Class Placement**

## A letter went home to all families this week, some of the highlights from the letter are as follows:

The placement of students each year is a task that our staff takes very seriously. We'd like to share with you the process and criteria that we use at Cana when we are setting up classes for the new school year. It is a lengthy, complex and thorough process, involving all teachers and school leadership, which we believe is essential to create well-balanced classes.

The Principal, following discussion with the teaching staff, will make the final decision regarding the structure of grades. Teachers are asked to list their preferences for teaching specific grades and specialist areas. Balancing classes also involves knowing about who will be teaching at Cana in 2025 and the year levels each teacher will take, this is usually not confirmed until later in the school year. Staff members will not disclose the composition of proposed classes prior to any formal announcements. The Principal, in consultation with the Deputy Principals and Leadership Team, will make the final decisions regarding the composition of the grades and which teachers will teach them. Students will visit their new grade for the following year on Orientation Day in the second last week of Term 4.

If you would like to request that your child be placed in a class with a particular friend or friends, please ensure that the school receives this request by **3:30pm on October 15th** so that we can consider your request in organising our classes for the following year. Emails received after this time will not be considered as information for placement due to the timeline of our placement process.

Requests for class placements must be made in writing, outlining who you would like your child to be placed with. Please explain in your communication why you believe it is important for us to know about the information you are sharing. We will not always be able to accommodate class placement requests, but will endeavour to take your wishes into consideration where possible. This is an opportunity for you to explain your child's learning needs and give us specific information that will help us make placement decisions in regard to your child. Statements describing student needs, family situations, or other issues are most helpful. In addition, please include information that is specific or unique to your child or particular circumstances influencing your child's learning that you would like us to consider. If you choose to email a letter, please put 'CLASS PLACEMENT 2025 LETTER' and 'YOUR CHILD'S NAME' in the subject area. Please do not make requests about a specific teacher. If a request for a specific teacher is included in the email, the email will be disregarded.

#### Please note that:

- Most parents will not need to place a peer request or provide information regarding their child's
  individual circumstances that require additional consideration. The more parent requests that are made
  the more complex the class placement process will be.
- Current teachers and leadership will be viewing the parent input as part of the class placement process.
- For reasons of privacy and confidentiality we are not able to share with parents and caregivers the reasons for some placements.

## **PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES**

Use of the Family ID as the reference ensures the owner of the payment for allocation and provision of receipt. This is particularly important in the event that the person making a school fee payment has a different surname to the surname listed on the school fee account.

The safety of each child at Cana is of the utmost importance. It is our duty of care to ensure each child feels safe within all environments including school, home, and the community.

To comply with the Ministerial Order No. 1359 – Implementing the Child Safe Standards, Cana is required to meet the Child Safe Standards 1-11. Below is an outline of each Child Safe standard. More information on each standard can be found here: The 11 Child Safe Standards

<u>Standard 1:</u> To establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued.

<u>Standard 2:</u> Child safety and wellbeing are embedded in organisational leadership, governance, and culture.

<u>Standard 3:</u> Children and young people are empowered about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously.

Standard 4: Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing.

Standard 5: Equity is upheld, and diverse needs respected in policy and practice.

<u>Standard 6:</u> People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.

Standard 7: Processes for complaints and concerns are child focused.

<u>Standard 8:</u> Staff and volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills, and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training.

**Standard 9:** Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed.

Standard 10: Implementation of the Child Safe Standards is regularly reviewed and improved.

<u>Standard 11:</u> Policies and procedures document how the school is safe for children and young people.

In future editions of the newsletter, each Child Safe Standard will be explored in further detail with examples of how it is implemented at Cana.
