

Dear Cana Catholic Primary School Students and Families,

Thank you for continuously supporting our school from time to time with our school fundraising events and activities.

We are very excited to announce that in Term 4, we will be hosting

Cana Catholic Primary School Color Explosion Run For Fun

to raise money for learning resources for our children!



To achieve our goal, we will need everyone's help in our school community – you can still start collecting donations now if you haven't already started and continue right through to the 30th of October 2024.

When is the Colour Explosion Fun Run?

We will be hosting Cana Catholic Primary Schools Colour Explosion Run on Wednesday 23rd October, 2024.

How does the Fun Run work?

All students who are given permission to participate will be covered in colorful, non-toxic, biodegradable colour powder from head to toe as they run laps of our Cana Catholic Primary School mapped out course. To participate in the Fun Run, all students must register online. You must also come to school in a WHITE t-shirt, casual bottoms (any colour), casual hat and runners to wear for the day and during the Fun Run.



Is the powder safe?

All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students. The non-toxic colour powder is made from 98% high quality corn starch and 2% permitted food colours, so it is safe for skin and eyes. It is non toxic, biodegradable and gluten free. The staff will do their best to aim the powder towards the torso, however wind may cause the powder to protrude onto your child's face or hair. Sunglasses and headbands will be provided for the students on the day.

The colour powder will likely wash out of your child's clothing. Nevertheless, we recommend that your child wears a plain white t-shirt and only clothing/shoes that you don't mind being coloured.



Fundraising Online

Your child can accept donations online by creating a cybersafe fundraising profile at myprofilepage.com.au. Once your page is set up, you can start collecting donations. Parent help is required to set up the online page. Track your progress towards your goal and see where you rank on our school's leader board. Raise \$10 to receive your first prize, but why stop there? Every dollar counts towards bigger prizes!

Note: By registering your child this will allow them to take part in the event. If your child will not be participating in the event please notify your classroom teacher that they will be spectating only.

On the day...

Parents are welcome to attend to watch the event and cheer on everyone participating. Gates will open from 1:15pm, however all parents will have to remain in the marked spectator zones.

Schedule for the day:

Prep & Grade 1 Students - 1:30pm till 2:00pm Grade 2 & 3 Students - 2:00pm till 2:30pm Grade 4,5 & 6 Students - 2:30pm till 3:00pm

Please note that due to safety concerns all students participating in the event will need to remain at school till 3:15pm with no early requests permitted on the day. When students are not running, they will be seated and supervised by their classroom teacher while cheering.

The Child Safe Standards

The safety of each child at Cana is of the utmost importance. It is our duty of care to ensure each child feels safe within all environments including school, home, and the community.

To comply with the Ministerial Order No. 1359 – Implementing the Child Safe Standards, Cana is required to meet the Child Safe Standards 1-11. Below is an outline of each Child Safe standard. More information on each standard can be found here: The 11 Child Safe Standards

<u>Standard 1:</u> To establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued.

<u>Standard 2:</u> Child safety and wellbeing are embedded in organisational leadership, governance, and culture.

<u>Standard 3:</u> Children and young people are empowered about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously.

Standard 4: Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing.

Standard 5: Equity is upheld, and diverse needs respected in policy and practice.

<u>Standard 6:</u> People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.

Standard 7: Processes for complaints and concerns are child focused.

<u>Standard 8:</u> Staff and volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills, and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training.

Standard 9: Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed.

Standard 10: Implementation of the Child Safe Standards is regularly reviewed and improved.

<u>Standard 11:</u> Policies and procedures document how the school is safe for children and young people.

In future editions of the newsletter, each Child Safe Standard will be explored in further detail with examples of how it is implemented at Cana.
