No Smoking or Vaping in or near the school grounds! A reminder to all parents/carers/visitors that there is no smoking or vaping in the school grounds. If any parent/carer continues to do so, I will be left with no option other than to exclude them from entering school grounds. Thank you for your understanding. Apart from the health concerns, it is illegal. The Victorian Government website states:

A person must not smoke cigarettes, including e-cigarettes (regardless of whether they contain nicotine or are prescribed for therapeutic use) within school premises and within 4 metres of any pedestrian access to school premises. Smoking in these places is a fineable offence. The smoking and vaping ban applies to:

- anyone present on school premises during and outside of school hours including students, teachers, contractors, parents or carers or the wider community, such as sporting groups
- all activities that take place on school premises including pre-schools, kindergartens, outside school hours care, cultural, sporting or recreational activities and school fetes.

2026 Preparation:

As we begin the process of planning for the 2026 school year, we want to inform families about our student placement procedures.

Our primary goal is to create balanced and effective classroom environments that will best support the academic and social growth of every student. We consider a variety of factors when forming class lists, including a balance of academic abilities, learning styles, social dynamics, and student needs. This is a complex process that our professional staff, including teachers, the Leadership Team and administration staff, handle with great care and consideration for the needs of all students.

To ensure the integrity and fairness of this process, we will not be accepting parent requests for specific teachers.

If you have a specific, educationally-relevant concern about your child that you believe is critical for us to know as we consider their placement (e.g., a specific learning need or a social-emotional consideration), please email me directly at alison.bretag@canahillside.catholic.edu.au by October 10th 2025. Please be aware that this is not a guarantee of a specific placement but is a way to share information that you feel is important for us to consider. **Please do not email classroom teachers- all requests should come directly to me.**

Social Justice Sunday: On Sunday it was Social Justice Sunday, and in a tradition reaching back to 1940, the Australian Catholic Bishops release major social justice statements each year in time for Social Justice Sunday. Through this tradition they contribute to the development of local Catholic Social Teaching. Please have a read if you get a spare moment- it reminds us that we are called to 'be the face of Christ in the world.'
